Base Lines:

Understanding the Will of God as stated in Romans12:12 Rejoicing in hope; patient in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer;

The baseline may require you to dust off your understanding a bit so you can focus on what Jesus has done in/with you when you **Truly** – emphasis – **Truly** accepted His Gift of salvation. That the Will of God expressed in His Word; You have a perfect ability and provision to be in prayer every second with your God.

Information.

The peace of our joining together of love between us and our God is something we can do and share every moment of every day. Who is it that says it ever has to end. Why do we feel that we cannot pray continually.

Philippians 4:6

Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.

Romans12:12

Rejoicing in hope; patient in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer;

Are we afraid that something would happen while we were praying? Would we wreck that car or stop our work or neglect our children? Does God not give us the ability to pray as we walk in our path?

Do you really believe that the God who would answer your prayer would cause your prayer, which he commands you do, to cause you harm?

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Perhaps you hold that position because you have a method of prayer that would allow that. If your method of prayer is restricted to only a type of prayer that would end up in harm if you did it continually, I submit to you that you are in error.

Do we have to be perfect to offer prayer?

Psalms 6:1-10

To the chief Musician on Neginoth upon Sheminith, A Psalm of David. O LORD, rebuke me not in thine anger, neither chasten me in thy hot displeasure. Have mercy upon me, O LORD; for I *am* weak: O LORD, heal me; for my bones are vexed. My soul is also sore vexed: but thou, O LORD, how long? Return, O LORD, deliver my soul: oh save me for thy mercies' sake. For in death *there is* no remembrance of thee: in the grave who shall give thee thanks? I am weary with my groaning; all the night make I my bed to swim; I water my couch with my tears. Mine eye is consumed because of grief; it waxeth old because of all mine enemies. Depart from me, all ye workers of iniquity; for the LORD hath heard the voice of my weeping. **The LORD hath heard my supplication; the LORD will receive my prayer.** Let all mine enemies be ashamed and sore vexed: let them return *and* be ashamed suddenly.

Does that sound like the prayer of someone who is perfect?

Ok do we have to be careful how we pray, chose our words carefully or some other silliness?

Romans 8:24-32

For we are saved by hope: but hope that is seen is not hope: for what a man seeth, why doth he yet hope for? But if we hope for that we see not, *then* do we with patience wait for *it*. Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what *is* the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to *the will of God*. And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to *his purpose*. For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate *to be* conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren. Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified. What shall we then say to these things? If God *be* for us, who *can be* against us? He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?

Philippians 4:6 Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.

Have you ever been faced with the urge to pray yet did not because of some pressing business or that phone call coming?

Psalms 5:2-3

Hearken unto the voice of my cry, my King, and my God: for unto thee will I pray. My voice shalt thou hear in the morning, O LORD; in the morning will I direct my prayer unto thee, and will look up.

Psalms 6:9

The LORD hath heard my supplication; the LORD will receive my prayer.

Psalms 55:17

Evening, and morning, and at noon, will I pray, and cry aloud: and he shall hear my voice.

Psalms 64:1

« To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. » Hear my voice, O God, in my prayer: preserve my life from fear of the enemy.

Psalms 86:1

« A Prayer of David. » Bow down thine ear, O LORD, hear me: for I am poor and needy.

You have time to pray. You want God's success in your efforts, you want God's provision, you want God's peace, you want the fruits of your labor to be good, you want your family well and blessed. Pray. That telephone call will wait. That rush to the store will wait.

Why not as you move ask God to help you?

Psalms 142:1

« Maschil of David; A Prayer when he was in the cave. » I cried unto the LORD with my voice; with my voice unto the LORD did I make my supplication.

Daniel 9:17

Now therefore, O our God, hear the prayer of thy servant, and his supplications, and cause thy face to shine upon thy sanctuary that is desolate, for the Lord's sake.

Matthew 21:22

And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive.

I have learned in my usual slow-witted way that Jesus makes time for prayer.

I feel the need, God's call on my soul and spirit to pray and I have decided that if required I will force my flesh aside to answer the call. I have learned that God freezes time around your prayer call.

He sets aside time to answer his call for praise, ministry, and worship. Deep in your heart you know your masters voice, the voice of your Shepherd. Heed his call brother and sisters for there is time sufficient for answer to his call for you to pray.

Set aside for a worship call on his will. He will provide time for his call. Just as he provisions all things in your life when you are in his will he will provision time for your answer to his call for prayer.

Exodus 34:14

For thou shalt worship no other god: for the LORD, whose name is Jealous, is a jealous God:

1 Chronicles 16:29

Give unto the LORD the glory due unto his name: bring an offering, and come before him: worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness.

Psalms 22:27

All the ends of the world shall remember and turn unto the LORD: and all the kindreds of the nations shall worship before thee.

Psalms 29:2

Give unto the LORD the glory due unto his name; worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness.

Psalms 66:4

All the earth shall worship thee, and shall sing unto thee; they shall sing to thy name. Selah.

Psalms 95:6

O come, let us worship and bow down: let us kneel before the LORD our maker.

He will provide that provision of time.

Proverbs 15:29

The LORD is far from the wicked: but he heareth the prayer of the righteous.

Answer God's call to prayer and he will honor the obedience and submission to his will in Covenant with him. Jesus is not playing Church or God. God requires your worship and when he calls, answer in faith. He will provide.

Hear him calling?

Feel him moving?

Want some Joy?

Need a faith boost?

Step out of your box and answer his call. Now is the time no excuse, move to his song and Jesus will place Joy in your heart, no way out just pure love.

Psalms 5:11

But let all those that put their trust in thee rejoice: let them ever shout for joy, because thou defendest them: let them also that love thy name be joyful in thee.

Zephaniah 3:17

The LORD thy God in the midst of thee is mighty; he will save, he will rejoice over thee with joy; he will rest in his love, he will joy over thee with singing.

Happiness in his worship is where you are, do not hesitate and miss the great grace that he will provide you. Now is the time to act. Go for it!

Psalms 43:4

Then will I go unto the altar of God, unto God my exceeding joy: yea, upon the harp will I praise thee, O God my God.
